

How this works

Quick tips so you're not guessing

- 1 Sign up**
Hit [Sign Up](#) to reserve your spot. If the event is ended, signup is disabled.
- 2 Submit details (Fly-In / Fly-Out)**
For most events, your route is shown here — just join in and fly!
- 3 Slots**
Slots space pilots out (especially for busy fly-ins). Pick one that works — it helps reduce congestion.
- 4 Network etiquette**
This event is on VATSIM. Use proper callsigns, follow ATC instructions, and be ready for holds / sequencing.

How Participation Works

- You may need to fly a specific aircraft or subfleet.
- Some events may require VATSIM participation.
- Certain events may tie into tours, awards, or bonus points.

If an event has special participation rules, they will be clearly listed on the event page.

Event Completion

To receive credit for an event:

1. Fly the correct route.
2. Submit your PIREP.
3. Ensure it meets all listed event requirements.

If the event includes awards or bonus points, those are typically processed after flight review.

Why Participate?

- Structured group flying
- Real-world simulation experiences
- Potential awards or recognition
- Opportunities to fly unique routes

They are one of the best ways to connect with other UVA pilots and staff.

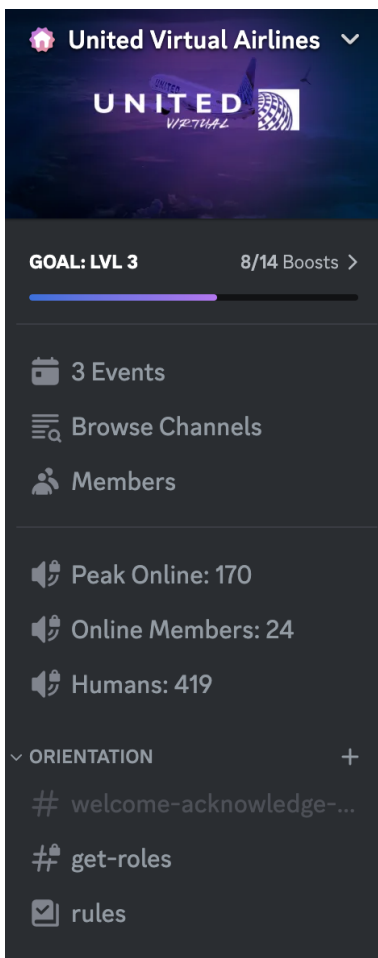

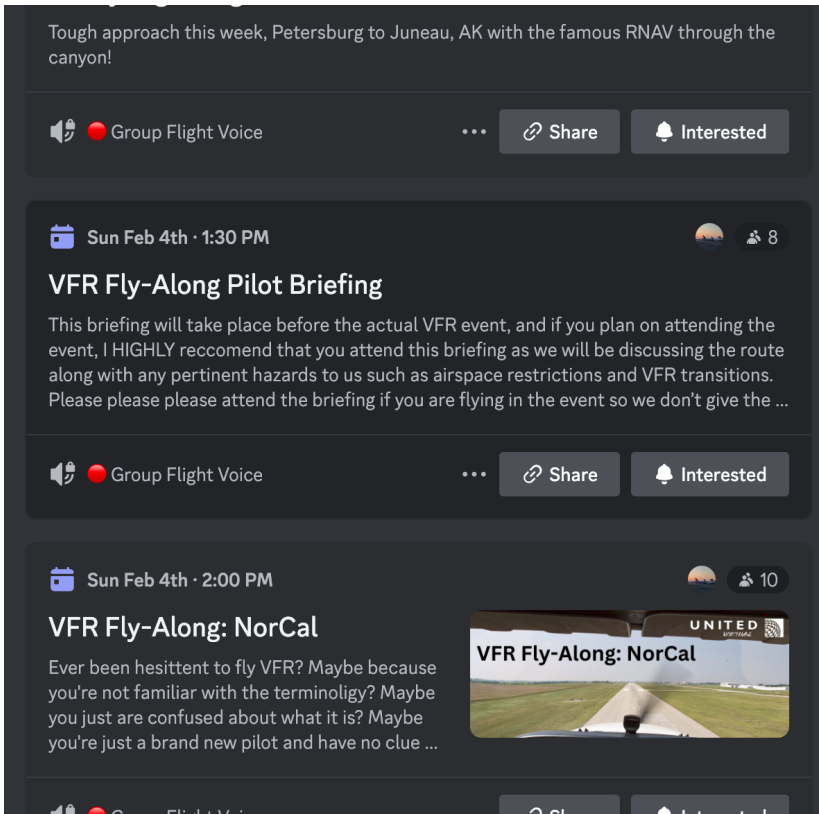
Discord membership is mandatory for event participation.

Insight into Events Details



Delve deeper into event specifics by

exploring the detailed information provided. Event Date, Time, and Description are readily available. The event time automatically adjusts based on your system clock, ensuring convenience. The event's designated voice channel is also highlighted at the bottom.

The event time listed automatically adjusts to whatever time-zone you're in based on your system clock.

Express your interest in an event by clicking the "Interested" button. This action notifies the staff of your intent without imposing any obligatory attendance. To share the event with friends on other Discord servers, use the "Share" button.

Clicking on a specific event within the pop-up window opens up a comprehensive overview, offering a deeper understanding of the event's nature and requirements.
